Sometimes a nurse is needed to provide wound care after surgery or a person recovering from a stroke needs physical and/or occupational therapy. VNA Home Health is here for you, your family, friends or neighbors.

Our Mission

Established in 1909, the Visiting Nurse Association of Hanover & Spring Grove brings professional health care to the home and teaches families how to care for their loved ones in all stages of life.



Services

Our nurses, therapists, social workers and home health aides provide a wide range of services including:

Skilled Nursing

RN's and LPN's provide direct patient care and education such as IV therapy, ostomy care, nutrition, wound management, maternal child health, disease management, telehealth, and high tech nursing.

Rehabilitation

Physical and Occupational Therapists develop treatment and exercise programs to assist patients with strength, endurance, range of motion and balance as well as restoring independence with activities of daily living such as bathing, dressing, and eating. Speech Therapists assist with verbal and non-verbal communication training and swallowing therapy.

Social Work

Social Workers assist with patients and their families with financial and social issues associated with their illness as well as help them access appropriate community services.

Home Health Aides

Home Health Aides assist patients with personal care, comfort measures and light household duties.

Service Area and Billing

We provide services to individuals living in Hanover, Spring Grove, the surrounding townships of southwestern York County and all of Adams County.

Referrals may be made by physicians, families, social service agencies, friends, clergy, hospital and nursing home discharge planners, or individuals who need services.

Care is always provided with physician oversight.

VNA will bill Medicare, Medical Assistance, insurances and other payers. If there is no source of payment, medically necessary services will be provided regardless of the individual's ability to pay.
