What We Do

Skilled Nursing Visits provide professional care for the patient to evaluate and manage pain and disease symptoms and to coordinate of services for both the patient and family.

Hospice Aides assist with personal care, comfort measures and homemaker services.

Trained Volunteers offer companionship, emotional support, respite care as well as assistance with other needs.

Spiritual Counseling is available for those who need assistance with spiritual matters.

Bereavement Services offer continued support to family and friends following the loss of a loved one.

How to Get Hospice Services

Contact VNA Hospice at 717-637-1227 or 800-422-3197.

We will quickly answer your questions and explain our hospice program. With your approval we will contact the attending physician to confirm the need for hospice care.

A hospice nurse or social worker will make a visit to evaluate needs, set up an individualized plan of care, and initiate services.

We will contact the patient's insurance provider to verify that coverage is available. Medicare, Medical Assistance (MA), and most private insurance plans have a hospice benefit. We will determine what coverage is available. VNA Hospice provides services to all patients, regardless of their ability to pay.

VNA Hospice service area includes Hanover, Spring Grove, the surrounding townships of southwestern York County and all of Adams County.
